CAPE LAND DEAL

A local realtor wants the City of Cape Coral to pay up.

Boback Commercial Group has hired an attorney to help collect more than \$650,000- money they believe is owed to them for a multi-million dollar land deal.

The company claims it told the City about 652 acres of land, purchased last month at auction.

A courier hand delivered the City Attorney and each Council Member a binder today detailing why the city owes their client money.

"We are not looking to take the city to task. It was a great opportunity for them. Council did a great thing. It will be a legacy for years to come. We feel like we helped but feel like they didn't get all the facts to say they did a good job and we ought to pay them."

Cape Coral Council Members declined to comment until they looked over the new documents.
